Pole Lane similar objection rate to development. Maybush would be acceptable if there was access from Badger Farm Road.</p> <p>There was some discussion about Bushfield Camp.</p> <p>HU 05 – Not many housing options</p> <p>HU13 – 20 houses maximum – access would be easy. In principle no objection. Beautiful view would be spoiled. Modest number with simple access.
