	<p>Introduction from William Griffiths from Novus and Nicola Jones attended the meeting.</p> <p>Cllr Rees declared an interest in the project.</p> <p>It would provide 20 megawatts over 20 acres. At the beginning it could be seen through some gaps along Sarum Road – which will be filled with native saplings/vegetation during development and fill in over time.</p> <p>It will be over looked by one resident and tree line will be placed to shield view.</p> <p>Public consultation at IBM next week to listen to concerns. 40,722 houses powered.</p> <p>No view from Farley Mount. There will be one phase only – limited by capacity.</p> <p>Substation within bank area – fairly small. Contacted all homes within 1.5mile radius with information and chance to come to public consultation.</p> <p>Timeline – Consultation next week – Tuesday 4th October.</p> <p>Submit to planning after 6 weeks, after permission build takes 4-6 months.</p> <p>Sheep can graze.</p> <p>Unfortunately, currently there is no battery storage allowed.</p> <p>There would be £250PMW to communities. £5000 per year for lifetime of project from once connected. 2023/2024 with Inova. Council felt they would support the application.</p>
